
**SUBJECT: Performance of Bio-Sys Chemical**

**TO:Mark**

I just wanted to pass along a quick note on how your microbial floor cleaner has dramatically cut down our BOD and SS (suspended solids) surcharges to the sewer district of Pekin, IL.. As you know, earlier this year we were seeing BOD and SS levels as high as 2500 ppm and monthly averages of 1300 ppm. This resulted in surcharges as high as \$15,000 Per month! Since the facility has been using your product, we have seen our numbers go down to around 550 ppm for BOD and 600 ppm for SS. This has resulted in a reduction in surcharges by over 90% and all this occurred by just changing to a different floor cleaner. In addition, Steve Dennis, our Food Service Admin. Has been very please at the economical price as well as performance of the product in all on all the floors and drains in the food service area.
