DIRECTIONS FOR USE:

BMIC-7 is designed to replace ordinary floor cleaners and caustic degreasers in a variety of general industrial situations where waste oils or grease are present. May be used as a floor cleaner in industrial kitchens.

FLOORS: Add 3-4 oz of BMIC-7 to each gallon of warm or cold water. Increase slightly for heavier cleaning, decrease for lighter soiled areas. Rinse with potable water in food preparation areas.

HEAVY SOIL: For heavy greasy deposits, add up to 8 oz per gallon to a mop bucket (4-5 gal). Spray or deck brush, rinse or squeegee.

APPLICATION: Slop mop, let stand for 5-10 minutes, deck brush or mop to aid cleaning, then rinse, dry mop or squeegee as necessary to remove excess liquid. BMIC-7 will work equally well in a foamer, pressure washer or floor machine.
